

Colorado Company Helps School District Save 47% on Energy Costs

Grand Junction, Colo. – March 21, 2006 – Save More Resources, Inc. (SMR) has been awarded the 2006 ENERGY STAR® Partner of the Year Award by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Department of Energy in the service and product category. Also earning the 2006 ENERGY STAR Partner of the Year Award is SMR client Gresham-Barlow School District of Oregon. This award program recognizes 67 U.S. organizations that help protect the environment through superior energy efficiency.

Since the implementation of its energy management program, the district has saved \$4.3 million and avoided utility costs of \$1.1 million for the 2004/2005 school year. Furthermore, the district was able to decrease its overall utility costs by 47 percent. These savings equate to the salaries of approximately 22 teaching positions. In recognition of this success, Gresham-Barlow school district has received the highly coveted ENERGY STAR Leadership Award and Partner of the Year Award.

Colorado Springs School District 11, also an SMR client, was awarded the 2005 ENERGY STAR Partner of the Year Award.
